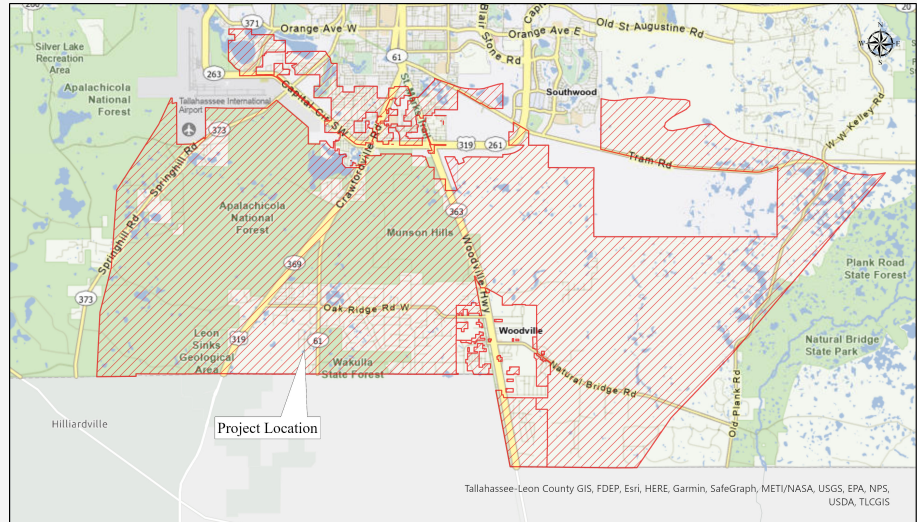

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Project Description

Leon County has been awarded \$2.22 million in grant funding from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) for the Leon County Septic Upgrade Incentive Program. The program will provide incentive payments up to \$7,500 to eligible recipients within the Wakulla Springs Priority Focus Area (PFA) for voluntarily upgrading or replace an existing conventional septic system to an advanced nitrogen-reducing system. The Septic Upgrade Incentive Program is available until all grant funding is thoroughly exhausted.
