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Project Description

The focus of this safety improvements project, funded by FDOT Local Agency Program, is to construct low-cost and effective safety features on and along the roadway to improve safety of the traveling public and adjacent property owners. The improvements must be completed within the existing right-of-way and without major roadway reconstruction, such as adjustment of roadway profile, addition of travel lanes, or full shoulder widening.

Proposed Improvements

The goal is to address Lane Departure type crashes along this segment of Old Bainbridge Road, while considering the canopy protection zone limitations. The existing roadway has two 11' lanes with no shoulders. The existing advanced warning and advisory signage for the horizontal

curves along this route do not appear to conform to existing standards for placement or retroreflectivity. The selected countermeasures include minor shoulder pavement, piping of steep ditches directly adjacent to edge of pavement, new signage, upgraded pavement markings, delineators, and possible radar feedback speed limit signs and shielding of obstructions in limited circumstances.
