Hello, my name is Micah Ramirez and I'm a county employee. I had the first code of the Moderna vaccine due to the mandate a while ago and had a reaction that led me to being temporarily blind (it's called near syncope). I just finished reading over the exemption paperwork and there's a concern that I have. As someone who won't be able to

be fully vaccinated I'm concerned over putting myself in danger by having to go to the health department weekly to get a COVID test while showing no symptoms.

Other people at the health department going in for testing most likely have symptoms and may have COVID, and by being potentially around them I could get it and carry it on to others.

From what I understand my testing would be free and provided by the health department and would be included as time paid. If I were also to go somewhere else other than the health

department there is the risk of getting exposed.

Would I have to schedule my own weekly testing? How would that work logistically with my work hours? What happens if I'm not able to be scheduled weekly?

Of all of the employees in my department I'm the only one who won't be able to be fully vaccinated, I'm the one at risk by not being vaccinated, yet I'm the one being made to go weekly and

put myself and others in danger. Not just of COVID but other things, since many people in the environments where testing takes place are there because they're sick. It's been shown that you can be vaccinated and still get COVID,

I know multiple people who have gotten COVID after they were fully vaccinated, including a county employee. I got the vaccine because I didn't want to be fired, and was temporarily blind because of it. I keep thinking about what would have happened to me if I had been doing something dangerous, like driving. I could have gotten myself or someone else killed, I wouldn't have had time to react and pull over to the side of the road. I had the reaction almost a full day after getting my first dose. Now I'm being made to put myself and others weekly at risk by being in an environment where I will be in the vicinity of people showing symptoms,

despite what safety measures are put into place. By the time I get my test results and submit them the beginning of each week I could already have it and gotten it from someone at the testing sight. I am willing to do weekly testing but my issue is the risk and how it works logistically with my hours. Would it be possible to have a specific time slot each week where testing is done by a health professional and county employees are able to schedule themselves in that timeslot to be weekly tested? This would create a safe environment as I and other employees being tested wouldn't be in the vicinity of people actually showing symptoms. I hope we can come to a solution where I and others who have exemptions are not put at further risk.
