Additional Information Regarding Agenda Item #17

This memorandum provides additional information regarding Agenda Item #17, "FY 2023 Insurance Coverages," scheduled for the December 13, 2022 Board of County Commissioners Meeting.

Agenda Item #17 provides information for the placement of necessary insurance coverage for 2023. Upon further review by the County Attorney's Office, Brown & Brown, is recommending that the County accept Cyber Security through ACE American Ins. Co., Chubb, which was quoted at \$53,440 with the extortion limit of \$1,000,000. Upon review by the County Attorney, it was determined that the original recommended provider (Homeland Insurance Co of NY) does not currently have all the required state business registrations.

 - Excess Workers' Compensation: Florida Municipal Insurance Trust, \$313,717
 - General Liability (including Public Official, Employment Practices Liability, Excess Liability, Auto and Medical Malpractice): The Phoenix Insurance Company, \$765,245, and Lloyds of London, \$9,739
 - Cyber Security: Homeland Insurance Co of NY, Intact \$55,000 ACE American Ins. Co., Chubb, \$53,440
 - As the broker of record, authorize Brown & Brown to place Pollution, Accidental Death & Dismemberment, Aviation, Crime and Drone liability coverages, \$177,276
